Have you lived in a facility for one year AND qualify for Medicaid?

You can ask for information about moving out of the place where you live now into the community through a Home and Community Based Services program that will assist you to get the supports and services you need.

What are Home and Community Based Services?



Offers everyone a choice to live with family and friends in an area they desire.



Helps people move into homes and apartments.



Transportation is available.



Offers support services that meet each person's daily needs, including help with medication and medical support.

The Process:

1. Meet with a Support Coordinator to choose your services based on your needs and wants. You can bring anyone you want to help you and answer questions.
2. Choose who you want to work with.
3. Create goals that are important to you.
4. Plan how to move from the facility into your new home.
