WHO DOES UWIPS HELP?

People who are currently receiving Social Security disability benefits (SSI/SSDI) and who would like information on how work may affect their Social Security and other benefits (e.g., Medicaid, Medicare, SNAP, housing).

WHY REFER?

To help people understand how working affects their Social Security and other benefits, as well as identify what work incentives they might be able to use.

WHEN TO REFER?

When a person is thinking about going to work or working more hours in their current job.



WHO CAN REFER?

Anyone who knows a person receiving Social Security disability benefits (SSI/SSDI) who is considering work. People can also refer themselves.

HOW TO REFER?

Complete a referral form and send it in to the program. You can get a referral form by calling 801-887-9530 or by going to jobs.utah.gov/usor/uwips.
