One of the strongest predictors of post-school employment success for young adults with disabilities is whether or not they held one or more paid jobs during high school. The importance of community-based assessments, job training, and paid employment opportunities, while still in school, have been well documented in achieving positive post-school outcomes.

Getting that first job can make a significant difference for students with intellectual and developmental disabilities. Finding the right job can be a challenge. Through a customized approach to employment, needed supports and conditions of employment are identifies. Student's unique interests and abilities are discovered and paired with the needs of a business in the community. Internship opportunities and paid work experiences during school are part of the Discovery process and create a rich profile and digital portfolio.

Customized Employment is a flexible process designed to personalize the employment relationship between a job candidate and an employer in a way that meets the needs of both. It is based on an individualized match between the strengths, conditions, and interests of a job candidate and the identified business needs of an employer. Customized Employment utilizes an individualized approach to employment planning and job development — one person at a time... one employer at a time.
