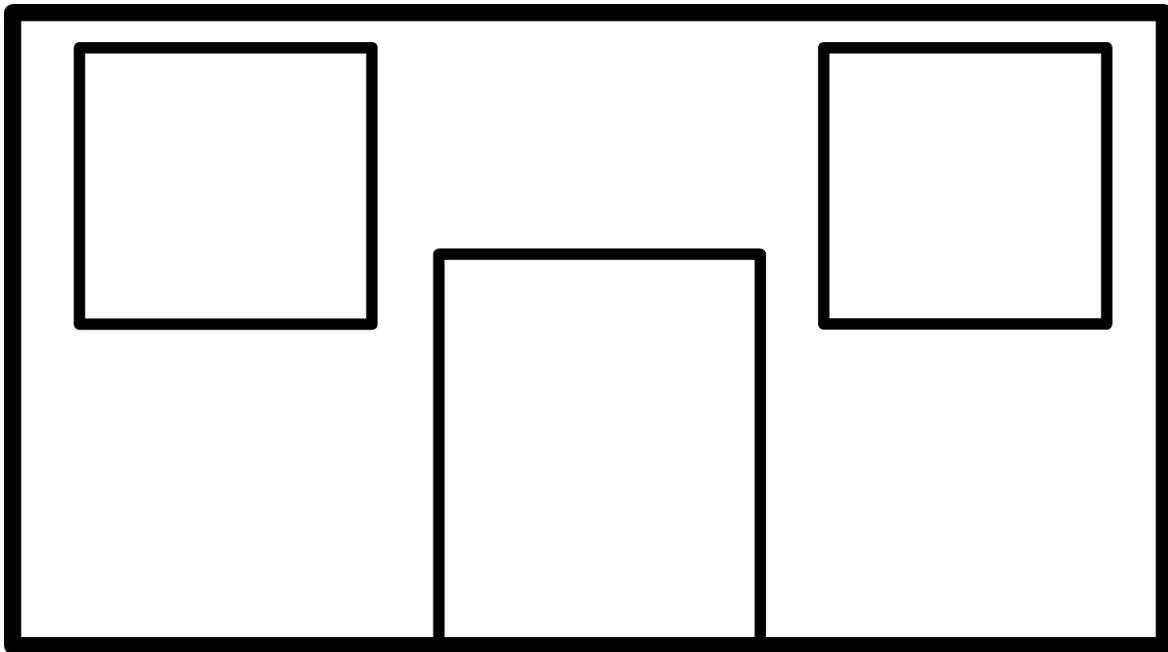

- You are encouraged to get in contact with the ABI program administrator to discuss the assessment in more detail. You can contact the ABI program administrator by calling (801) 809-5391.
- You may practice this assessment multiple times under supervision and guidance from an ABISC/ T (Trainer) to get a feel on how to administer it. The practice will be as follows:
  1. Observe the administration (by an ABISC or an ABISC/T) of the assessment to an actual client.
  2. Administer the assessment for ABISC certification to an actual client under ABISC/T supervision.

  - Understand how to direct questions to a person with ABI.
  - Understand how to score each question.
  - Understand that the score needs to be within 36-136.
