- The HSRI contract was extended for them to do some wrap-up.
- The annual eligibility review, PCSP validations, etc., do not require the UCANS to be completed for people on the Acquired Brain Injury Waiver. Support coordinators can choose to record the UCANS for a person on the ABI waiver if they want.

HMA final report

- Final rate report/rate models were presented on Dec. 19
- Next steps:
 - Extend contract to work on implementation
 - Starting a workgroup on how to implement

Budget neutral update

- Implementation has been delayed for the Request for Needs Adjustment project.
- Projected pilot phase and go-live date is now the last quarter of Fiscal Year 2026.

Legislative update

- The governor released his budget recommendations in December.
 - These recommendations included funding for mandated additional needs.
- We provide information and data to the Legislature as needed throughout the session.

Caregiver compensation

- Caregiver compensation is a **supported living** code.
- Please rely on Rule and the Self-Administered Services agreement for implementation.

- Please make sure you are not double-billing caregiver compensation with other services.

- New help manual for USTEPS, UPO and MySTEPS to be released in February.

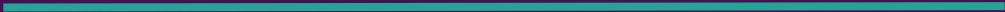
811 project rental assistance
